## FLOOR HOCKEY STUDY GUIDE

1. In hockey there are six positions; goalie, right defense, left defense, center, right wing and left wing.

2. A regulation goal net is 6 feet wide and 4 feet tall.

**3.** There are four types of shots in hockey: the wrist shot, snap shot, slap shot and backhand.

4. In floor hockey there is absolutely <u>no checking</u> and protective glasses must be worn at all times.

5. A regulation ice rink is 85 feet wide and 100 feet long. An Olympic rink is 100 feet by 200 feet.

6. To start a game and after each goal is scored, a faceoff takes place.

7. The puck must completely cross the goal line for a goal to be scored.

8. In floor hockey, sticks should not be raised above the waist.

9. A regulation hockey game is broken into three periods of play.

10. In regulation hockey, a minor penalty is two minutes, a major penalty is five minutes and a misconduct penalty is ten minutes.

**11.** A power play for your team is when the other team has one or more players in the penalty box.
